Seller's Checklist: How to List and Sell Your Car Safely

Prepare Your Car for Photos

Clean the exterior and interior. Remove personal items. Take clear photos in daylight, including the front, rear, sides, interior, dashboard, and any notable features. Highlight recent work such as new tyres, servicing, or upgrades.

Gather Important Information

Buyers expect accurate and complete details. Prepare the following: make, model, year, mileage, engine size, transmission, fuel type, colour, service history, number of owners, and any known issues.

Set a Fair and Competitive Price

Research similar listings in North Cyprus to understand market value. Consider age, mileage, condition, and service history. A realistic price attracts serious buyers and leads to faster sales.

Be Honest About Condition

Transparency builds trust. Declare any faults, accidents, repairs, or warning lights. Honest listings reduce wasted time and avoid disputes.

Respond Promptly to Enquiries

Buyers often contact multiple sellers. Quick and polite responses increase your chances of securing a sale. Answer questions clearly and provide additional photos if needed.

Arrange Viewings Safely

Meet buyers in public places where possible. Avoid letting strangers test drive your car alone. Check their driving licence before starting a test drive.

Finalise the Sale

Properly Prepare a simple written receipt including both parties' names, ID numbers, date, payment method, and the car's key details. Only hand over the car once payment has been confirmed in full.
