Buyer's Tips: How to Purchase a Car Safely in North Cyprus

Buying a used car should be straightforward, but it's important to check a few key things before handing over money. Use the guide below to make informed decisions and avoid common pitfalls.

1. Inspect the Vehicle Carefully

Take time to look over the car in daylight. Check for:

- Bodywork damage, mismatched paint or poor repairs
- Tyre condition and even wear
- Warning lights on the dashboard
- Interior condition and signs of heavy use
- Any oil leaks, unusual noises or excessive smoke

Bring a mechanic or knowledgeable friend if you're unsure.

2. Verify the Car's Details

Before committing to a purchase:

- Confirm the registration and chassis number
- Check the service history and maintenance records
- Ensure the mileage looks consistent with the vehicle's age
- Ask about recent repairs or known issues

If information seems unclear, ask more questions — legitimate sellers will be transparent.

3. Take a Proper Test Drive

Always test drive the vehicle. Pay attention to:

- Steering response
- Brake performance
- Gearbox behaviour
- Acceleration and engine smoothness
- Any vibrations, noises or warning lights

This is one of the best ways to identify problems early.

4. Agree on a Fair Price

Compare the asking price with similar vehicles in North Cyprus. Consider:

- Make and model demand
- Year and mileage
- Condition and service history
- Any included extras (warranty, new tyres, recent servicing)

Don't be afraid to negotiate if the price seems high.

5. Complete the Transaction Safely

For your protection:

- Meet in a public place or at the seller's property
- Avoid large cash payments unless necessary
- Write down a simple receipt with both parties' details
- Confirm the seller is the rightful owner before paying
- Do not transfer money before seeing the car in person

If something feels wrong, walk away.
